A well-known New Plymouth resident, Sister Elizabeth Ellis, was found dead yesterday afternoon in her flat at the corner of Hine and Weymouth Streets. It is thought that she died on Monday night.

An inquest was opened this morning before the district coroner, Mr. W. H. Woodward, S.M., and, after evidence of identification had been given, was adjourned sine die.

Sister Ellis was the proprietor Timata Ora maternity hospital. years ago her keen and consistent interest in mountain activities was recognised by her election as a life member of the Taranaki Alpine Club, of which she was one of the first members. As an army nursing sister she served in Britain and France during the last war, and after her arrival in New Zealand she took part in the Anzac Day parades at New Plymouth and was always actively associated with the re-union teas held in the afternoon by Mrs. Ann Burgess.

Sister Ellis, whose people live at Liverpool, met her husband, the late Mr. W. Ellis, when she was nursing him after he was wounded in France. Mr. Ellis, who died at New Plymouth many years ago, was a son of Colonel Ellis, a Maori war veteran. Her only son, Mr. H. Ellis, was in Auckland being examined for entry into the navy when the death was discovered and he returned to New Plymouth by this morning's express train.
