Description

The ANZ Bank is a prominent corner section building built up to the edge of the footpath. The building is constructed of timber with French imported tiles on the roof.

History

The ANZ Bank building was purpose built to house the Bank of Australasia and has been used for banking purposes ever since. It is currently a branch of the ANZ Bank and the only bank still operating in the town.
