DEATH OF MR. J. C. MOREY

A well-known New Plymouth business-man for many years, Mr. James Clewer Morey, died in New Plymouth yester-day. He was 80 years of age. Mr. Morey's father, the late Mr. Walter Morey, came to New Plymouth in the 1880's from Nelson. He began the business taken over by Mr. James Morey on his father's death. Under his direction a limited company was formed. He retired from business in 1936.

Mr. Morey was a keen bowler and was one of the early members of the New Plymouth Bowling Club when its greens were in Brougham Street. When he retired to live in Westown he joined the West End Club.
