



New building to cost £67,000

A £67,000 building is to be erected for MacEwans Machinery Ltd at the corner of Robe and Devon Sts, New Plymouth. A contract for the building has been let to H. F. Snowden Construction Ltd and work will begin as soon as the site is cleared and a permit granted.

The ANZ Bank's old wooden building on the corner is being demolished to make way for the modern premises.

The two-storey building will have concrete floors and walls with a steel-framed roof covered with galvanised steel trough roofing. The building will have a gross floor area of 21,295 sq ft.

At present the company operates from three premises in New Plymouth and the new building will allow the company to consolidate on one site.

The new premises will

comprise two retail showrooms (one facing Devon St and the other facing Robe St), parts and general bulk stores and offices.

A service lane from Robe St will give access to an open area behind the building. The area extends through to Powderham St. It is hoped the building will be occupied within 12 months.

The company's existing premises in Devon St next to the bank site will continue to be used by the company, but its King St building will be offered for sale.
